For over 1500 years after we received the Torah on Har Sinai, the Torah sheba'al peh, the Oral Torah, was exactly that – transmitted orally from teacher to student. Just over 1800 years ago, Rabbi Yehuda HaNasi began the arduous process of writing down the Oral Torah, with the compiling and editing of the Mishnah. We take a closer look at some of the significant periods, persons, and books in the history of the recording of the Oral Tradition BY ROBERT SUSSMAN
